2. COMPOSITION / INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS

3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Main hazards: No significant hazard. **Other hazards:** Irritating to eyes. Irritating to respiratory system. Irritating to skin.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES (SYMPTOMS)
